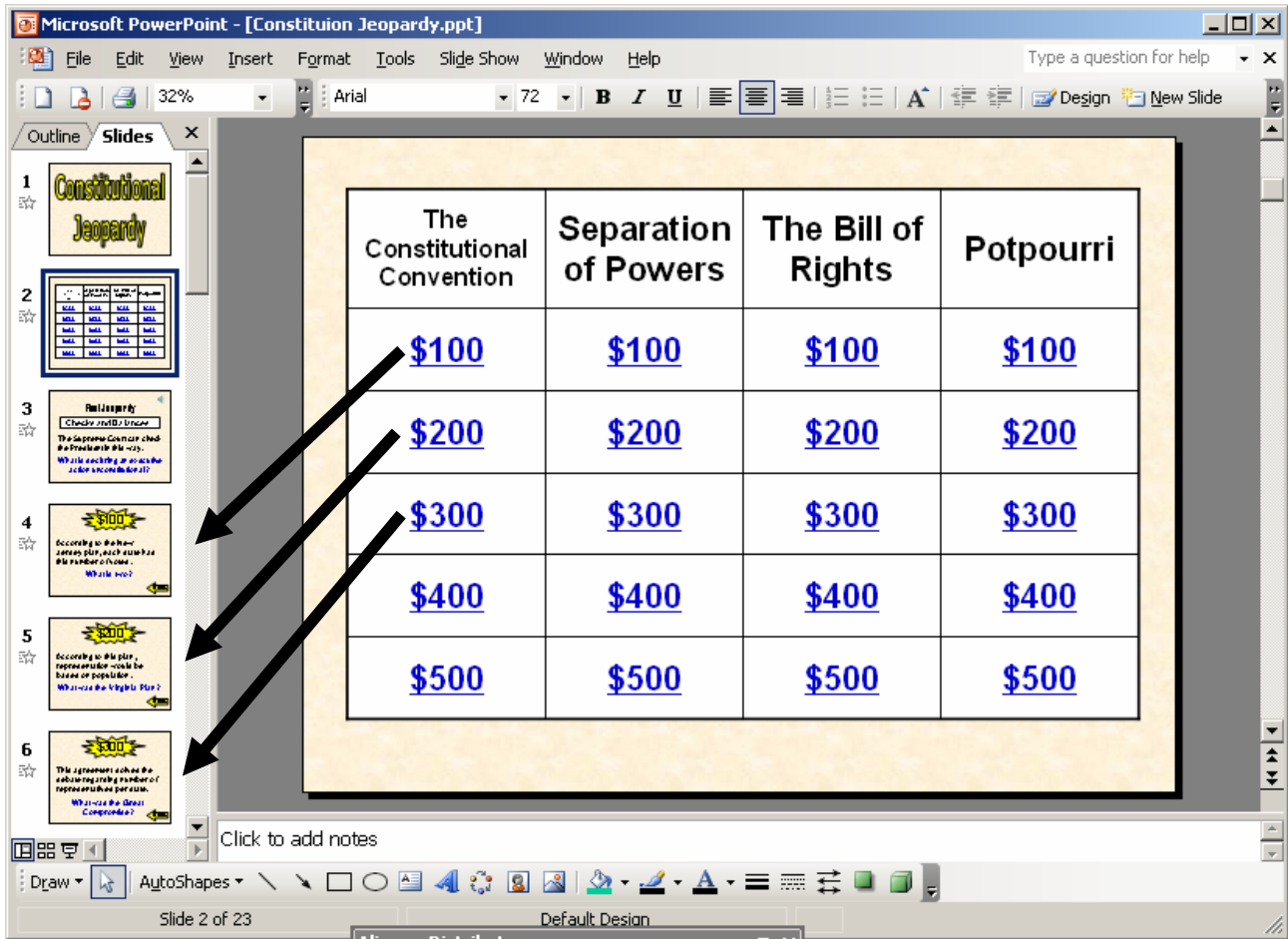


About Jeopardy PowerPoint

Setting Up the Game Board


Each of the dollar values links to another slide. Thus, the \$100 clue in category 1 links to slide 4.

Navigating to/from Clues



Final Jeopardy

Page down from the game grid to get to the Final Jeopardy clue.

1. Students see the category and write a wager on their papers.
2. Students see the clue and write a question on their papers.
3. Teacher collects papers.
4. Students get to see the question to find out if they were correct.

Clicking the speaker icon will play the Jeopardy theme (30 seconds long). If it doesn't play (because you've moved the files), you may need to re-insert the sound file.
