Downloading Images from Document Camera to a Mac

These steps walk you through the process of how to move the images that you took using the Document Camera's Capture functionality onto your computer. Once the images are on the computer, there are endless possibilities.

To download images:

Important: DO NOT connect the USB cable to the computer before you begin.

1. Make sure the camera is in **Camera Mode** (the Camera light is lit).
2. On the Document Camera or the remote, press the **MENU** button. On your screen, the menu options display.
3. Press the **down arrow** ▼ to highlight **Advance**.
4. Press the **right arrow** ►. The Advance menu displays.
5. Press the **down arrow** ▼ to highlight **USB Select**.
6. Press the **right arrow** ►.
7. Press the **down arrow** ▼ to highlight **IMG Download**.
8. Press the **right arrow** ►.
9. Now attach the USB connector first to the computer and then to the document camera.

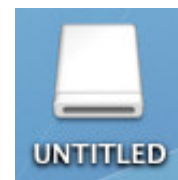

10. The document camera will appear as a volume on the desktop named **UNTITLED**.
11. Open iPhoto by clicking the icon in the Dock.



12. Within iPhoto, click **File > Import to Library**, then browse to **UNTITLED** (the document camera) on the Desktop, select the directory named **jpeg**, then click **OK**.
13. The pictures will be accessible from the Library. You can then create albums as needed. To create an album, click the **+** button in the bottom left corner. To add photos to an album, just drag them from the library to the album.
