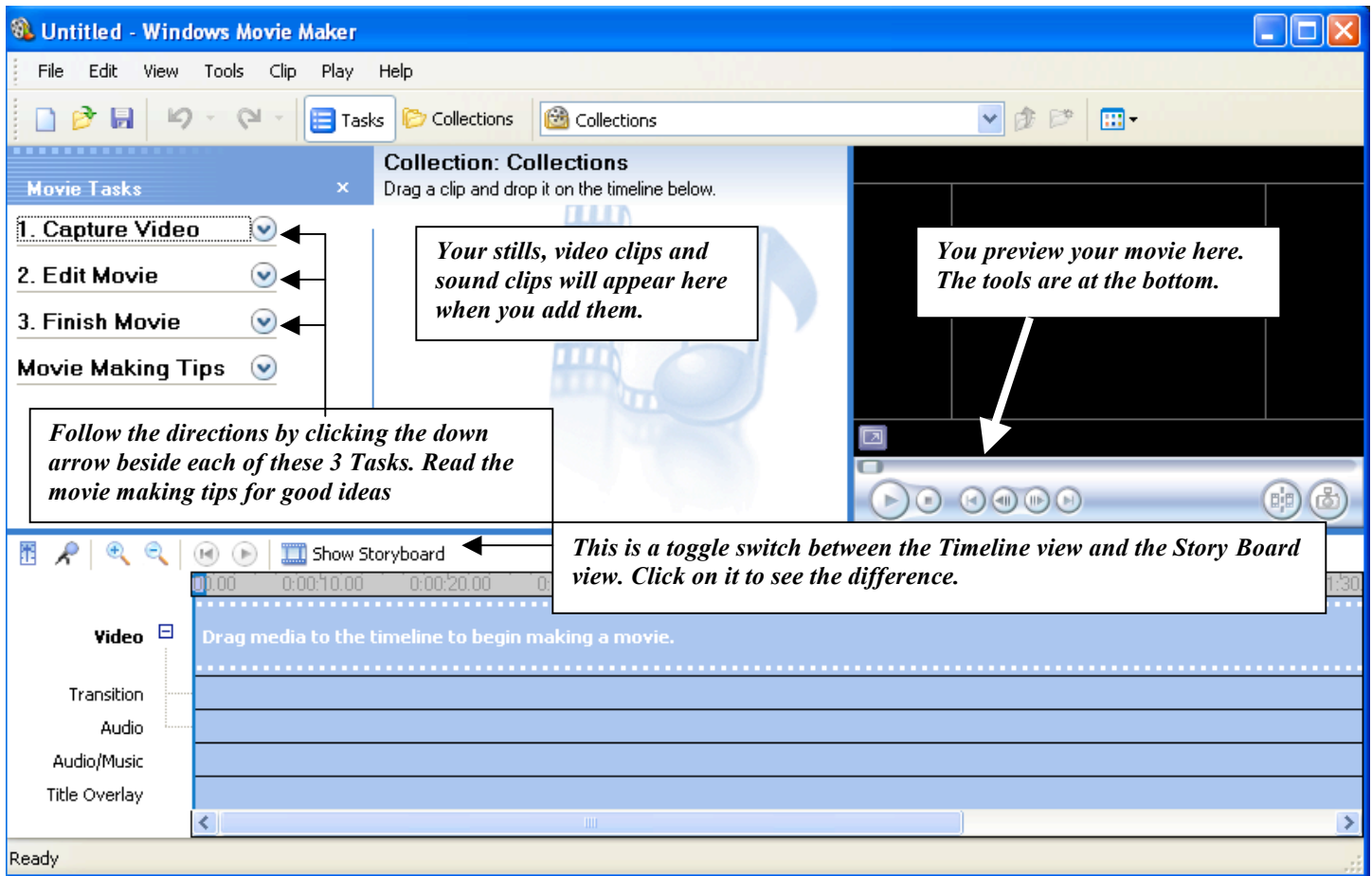


Movie Maker

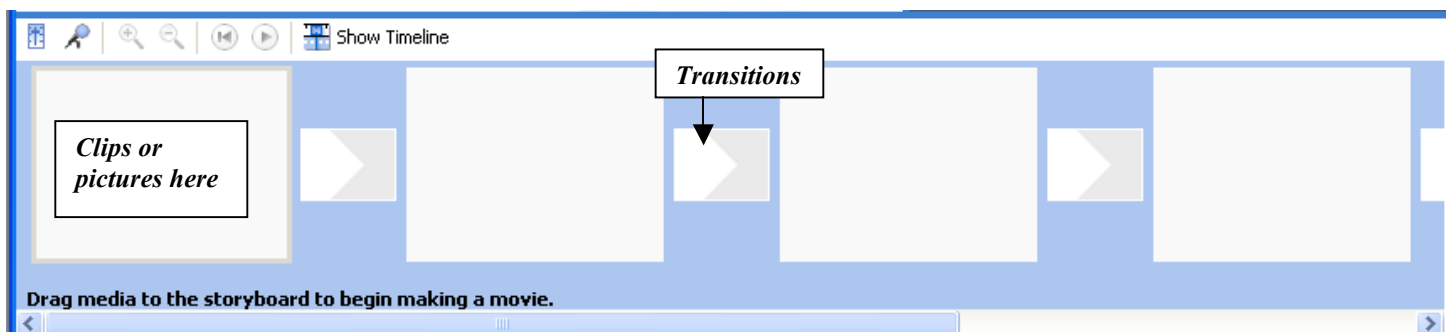
➤ A Quick Guide

When you first open **Movie Maker** this is what you will see on your screen.



The picture below shows what the **Storyboard** feature looks like. When you are first putting your media together this is a simple place to start since you can grab your clips and drag them into the big boxes and drag the transitions between pictures or clips into the smaller boxes in between. This makes it easier to place the transitions and to move the clips around if you want to. Drag title in front of first clip and credits to the end of the last clip

Note: You can do the same thing in the timeline view above which breaks your media into different tracks for you.

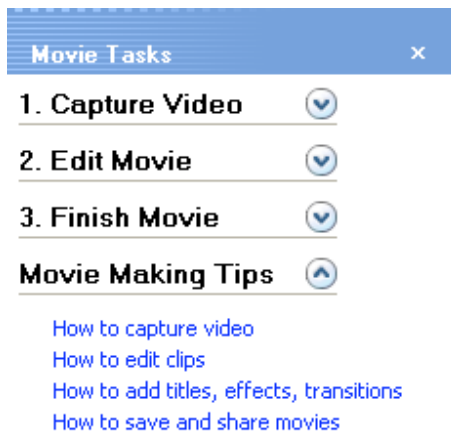
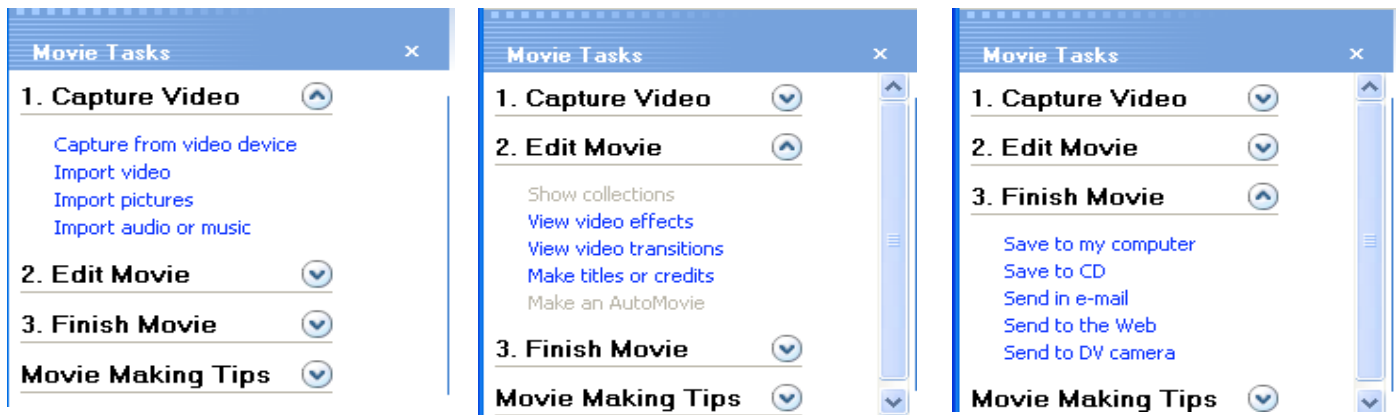
When you click on the blue links under each Task you will get information that guides you through each step of putting together your movie. Start with 1 and continue through 3. If you have questions, the Movie Making Tips section is really helpful as is the Help button in the Menu at the top of the page.

Task 1: Allows you to import video, still pictures and audio (narration) or music.

Task 2: Edit Movie is where you add video effects and video transitions.

Video effects are effects you add to the video or the picture itself. Video transitions are how you decide to move from clip to clip or picture to picture. Remember: you can make a great movie with still pictures.

Task 3: Allows you to save your movie in many ways.



The tips in this section entitled, **Movie Tasks** are very helpful and guide you through many items that you will want to do with your movie. Look through them as you work with your movie
